The following information, guidelines and policies are for those involved in performing at the Zion Canyon Farmers Market.

The ZCFM is located on the lawn of the Bit N Spur Restaurant located at: 1212 Zion Park Blvd, Springdale, Utah

Market hours are Saturdays from 9am – 12:00pm. Performance times will be from 10:00 to noon (with one break) Your performance should begin close to 10am. Set up as early as 9:00 am. Your performance, with adequate breaks, should run through 12:00 with one break.

Contact person upon arrival at the ZCFM is Lisa Zumpft (or the appointed Market manager for the day).

A power source and a power cord/power strip will be provided. Musicians will set up and play in the shade of a tree. Musicians shall provide their own PA system.

Compensation for our performance this year will be based on:

- A \$75.0 check from the Zion Canyon Farmers Market. Funding provided by the Zion Canyon Arts & Humanities Council (Z-Arts) and Zion Harvest
- Tips: placed in guitar case. Signage supports tipping.
- Donations received for CDs and other related merchandise. You may establish a donation price for these.
- Donations from local businesses and ZCFM vendors when available
